PARKING REMINDER

Can we be honest about parking in Boulevard Lane? The reality is that legal street parking is limited, particularly on cul-de-sacs.

WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT UPDATE

Boulevard Lane will soon be receiving a significant upgrade as the Soos Creek Water & Sewer District will be replacing the aging and undersized water mains that are located throughout our neighborhood. According to the SCWSD website: The water mains were installed between 1965 and 1970 and are reaching the end of their useful life as well as being undersized based on current codes and regulations. We've also experienced numerous leaks/breaks in the area. Replacement of the water mains will reduce the number of leaks/breaks, maintenance costs, and increase reliability and fire flow in the neighborhood.

You may recall that the project team was in our neighborhood last summer completing surveys and other preliminary design activities. Construction was expected to begin in early 2020. According to SCWSD, the project is still moving forward, but it has been delayed due to the pandemic. It is impossible to know for sure when the work will commence, but they are hoping for a late June/early July start.
